SKILLS GAPS - APPRENTICES IN MANUFACTURING

63% of UK manufacturers are now either using or planning to use apprenticeships and internships to grow their workforce while developing the skills they need.

This statistic highlights how manufacturers are rethinking their workforce demographic in order to overcome the industry's lack of workers with specialist technical skills. However, while this is a promising solution to the skills gap, a recent report has revealed that just 6% of 16 to 24-year-olds are considering a career in manufacturing.
